Policy Name: Uniform Policy

Supercedes: April 11, 2011

Mission Statement

It is one of the major goals of the Association to provide to the children of the community, through various baseball programs and events, opportunities for enhanced personal development and the opportunity to learn and experience the ideals of team work, good sportsmanship, and respect for others and for authority and to gain an appreciation for the efforts by an importance of volunteers in our society; and to further provide to the community all the advantages and opportunities associated with having a well developed and organized baseball program operating therein.

Rationale:

To maintain consistency among our teams and ensure proper branding and representation of the Association.

Details:

The scope of this policy is to describe the uniforms Performance, Competitive, Community and House League teams are to wear when representing Sherwood Park Minor Baseball ("SPMBA").

Procedure:

Uniform Usage:

Only official SPMBA assigned/branded jerseys and uniforms shall be worn by players in all games (league, exhibition, any tournament, Western and National Championships) while representing SPMBA.

House League Uniforms:

All House League team uniforms will consist of:

Assigned Jersey Black Baseball Pants House League Ball Cap

House League jerseys distributed to coach/manager of each team are to be returned at the end of the house league season (laundered and in good order).

Rep Uniforms:

The required uniform items for each rep player is as follows: Athletics Jersey

	Athletics T-shirt Athletics Baseball Cap White Baseball Pants Green Belt/Green Socks
Optional uniform items for each rep player is as follows:	Mock Shirt (long sleeve) Under Armour (long sleeve) Athletics Jacket/Hoodie

Each player is required to pay a deposit of \$75.00 per jersey to SPMBA. The deposit will be returned to the player at the conclusion of the season provided the jersey is returned clean and in good order.

Requests for deviation from this Uniform Policy are to be submitted to the Uniform Director and VP (Rep / HL) and President in writing and cannot be purchased until approval is received in writing.

Failure to comply with this policy can lead to disciplinary sanctions.
