  - Association still owes Kim & Pat Smyth \$3,500 Long Term Liabilities. Suggested to make payment of \$2,500 on amount owing to reduce debt as we are in a good place with other expenses. Kirk made a motion to pay Kim & Pat Smyth \$2,500 for partial repayment of Long Term Liabilities Ioan. Dan seconded. All in favour. Motion Passed. Action: Kirk to send payment of \$2,500 to Kim & Pat Smyth.

#### CALL updates from KIM

- Next week at CALL Meeting will decide official season start date, will be early April. Waiting on floor availability in different municipalities to make decisions.
- CALL Rule Changes: Mini tykes, tykes, and novice; Novice full contact back in effect, as place & push. Tyke is regular game rules, no skills & drills, straight to play. (In the back of the Canadian Lacrosse Association Rules & Regulations Handbook for 2017- 2018, "Option L" adopted across Alberta) Coach certification will be checked prior to the season starting; checked by ALA and CALL.

### • Coaches

- Kim Coach certification is a requirement. Up to PeeWee, they need community development. Bantam, Midget & up also require Comp Intro. Suggestion of our coaches to get the next level certification before requirement. Coach clinic dates are up on ALA website already.
- Kim When we start playoffs for CALL, we will need to have everyone fully trained (not in training) for those taking Comp Intro.
- Katie Hoping for a Coaching Director to organize coaches at the beginning of the year, keeping an eye on certifications, and hoping to head up development opportunities throughout the year.

## • Equipment

- If Dan takes on VP role, he will agree to equipment management again this year.

- Website set up fee reduced from \$500 to \$350, Annually fee reduced from \$600 to \$450. Option to enable Team App (similar to TeamSnap) for \$25/year per team. Domain transfer, \$25. Annual renewal of Domain, \$25.
