SLA Harassment Policy

THE SASKATCHEWAN LACROSSE ASSOCIATION AND MEMBER CLUBS WILL NOT TOLERATE HARASSMENT OF ANY TYPE.

This includes but is not limited to:

- Sexual Harassment
- Racial Harassment
- Abuse of Authority
- Inappropriate Name Calling/Jokes/Etc. is deemed a form of Harassment!

We are asking referees to police harassment of any type during lacrosse games and assess the appropriately penalty for box lacrosse as per Rule 28 (c) or Rule 48 – Gross Misconduct and for men's field lacrosse as per rule 75 or rule 78.

BOX LACROSSE

- 28 (c) A minor penalty for unsportsmanlike conduct shall be assessed to a player/goalkeeper who attempts to incite, through gestures or verbalization, an opponent into incurring a penalty or an additional penalty. A ten-minute misconduct penalty shall be assessed to a player/goalkeeper who continues the incitement after being assessed the minor penalty.
- 48 (a) The Referee shall assess a gross misconduct penalty to any player/goalkeeper or non-playing personnel who:
 - (i) Makes derogatory comments based upon race ethnic origin, religious background or gender.

MEN'S FIELD LACROSSE

- No player, substitute, non playing member of a squad, coach or anyone officially connected with a competing team shall:
- iii) use threatening, profane or obscene language or gestures to an official or to any member of the opposing squad;
- Refusal to accept authority of the officials, or the use of foul or abusive language may be an expulsion foul.
