Games:

- Each team will be playing 4 games minimum
- 5 minute warm up
- Two 15 minute stop time periods
- Third Period 20 minute stop time
- Actual clock with override time clock in the event of a long game
- Penalties will be 2 minutes stop time
- “Hand Shake” to follow all games
- Games ending in a tie will remain that way

In the interest of sportsmanship, all teams will “shake hands” with the other team and game officials after each game.

Coaches or managers will be required to verify player rosters 15 min. prior to each game.

Rules:

The rules followed are as laid out by the C.H.C., B.C.A.H.A. and N.V.I M.H.A. rule books

Abuse of Officials by players, coaches, parents or fans will not be tolerated.

TriPort Minor Hockey has a three penalties rule. Any player taking 3 penalties in a game will be ejected from that game. If a player takes a major penalty in the last 10 minutes of a game they will be suspended from the following game as well.

Should the incident occur, any player penalized for fighting or intent to injure will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
