**Team Rosters:** Please list all participating players on the registration form. Prior to the tournament a copy of your HCR must be submitted as well.

**Acceptance:** Applications will be accepted on a first paid, first in basis. Team entries will not be processed until a cheque is received. Cheques will be cashed upon acceptance.

**Tournament Activities:** There will be a luncheon for players and team officials on Saturday afternoon and a Halloween-themed social event Saturday evening. There will be no charge for these events, and teams are encouraged to participate. There will also be tournament prizes for each player, raffle table, 50/50's, hot chocolates for coaches during games and a snack table.

**Cancellation Policy:** Registered teams that cancel within 21 days or less of the tournament start date will only be refunded their registration fee if another team is available to fill their spot. Registered teams that cancel earlier than 21 days before the tournament start date will be refunded 100% of their registration fee.

#### 2017 TOURNAMENT RULES

- Round robin style, with finals to follow. Each team is guaranteed 4 games total.
- Games have a 75-minute time limit with the following breakdown:
  - o 5 minute running-time warm-up
  - Three 15 minute stop-time periods
  - o 2 minutes between periods
  - 5 minute handshake & awards ceremony
  - WALL CLOCK OVERRIDES TIME CLOCK if the time clock is still running, the buzzer will sound
    5 minutes before the scheduled end time for the game, based on the wall clock
- We ask that all players, coaches, managers and parents do what they can to help stay on track.
- All teams will shake hands with the other team and officials after the game. *Players please remove your gloves.*
- Round robin points awarded as follows:
  - o 2 points for team that wins game (1 point for each team if tie)
- Playoff placement will be determined by:
  - 1. Most points
  - 2. Most wins
  - 3. Head to head
  - 4. Fewest goals against
  - 5. Least penalty minutes
  - 6. Coin toss
- Starting line ups will be waived Coaches or managers will be required to verify player rosters 15 minutes before each game.

### • RULES:

- As per Hockey Canada, BC Hockey & V.I.A.H.A rule books.
- NOTE Tri Port Rule A player who receives his/her 3<sup>rd</sup> penalty in the same game will be ejected from the game.
- All protests are to be made in writing to the Tournament Coordinator.
- Shoot Out Rules (Playoff Games Only):
  - Each team will select 5 shooters. Teams will then alternate shooters. Visitors shoot first. If the tie is not broken after the first round of 5 shooters then sudden death shoot out until the tie is broken. A shooter cannot shoot twice.

Abuse of officials by players, coaches, parents or fans will not be tolerated
