WCMHA INITIATION 1/2 ICE PROGRAM

Following HC & HA Initiation ½ Program Guidelines

- 1. All players 6 years and younger will be classed as Initiation.
- 2. Play will be on ½ ice.
- 3. Ice will be divided in half by pylons, small board, or rink dividers.
- 4. Blue 4-ounce pucks will be used.
- 5. No off sides or icings will be called.
- 6. Coaches (one per team) may be on ice.
- 7. Referees will be used (one per game) to train young referees. Referees will talk to the coach after the 1st offence and award a 3-minute penalty after the 2nd offence.
- 8. Only a goal stick will be used, no other goal equipment.
- 9. A three-goal limit per player will be in effect.
- 10. A scorekeeper will track when one player has scored three goals and complete the scoresheet.
- 11. There will be a line change every 3 minutes.
- 12. A timekeeper will sound a buzzer every 3 minutes.
- 13. Teams will be 4 players and a goalie per team.
- 14. Full-sized or ³/₄ sized nets will be used, not Pond Hockey nets.
- 15. There will be three 21-minute periods, unless time is limited.
- 16. There will be a face-off at beginning of the game and after every goal. The referee will drop the puck. After a goalie covers the puck, a coach will throw the puck into a corner. After a 3minute shift, the referee will retrieve and throw the puck into a neutral corner after both teams have completed the line change.
- 17. Teams will be determined at beginning of season and turned in to WCMHA.
- 18. WCMHA will supply a league governor. Change of Game Notices and gamesheets must be submitted to the governor.
