That did it for the scoring in the second period. Even a two-minute holding call against Olympiens #25 Celine Matyl failed to yield a result. In the third period, the intensity of the play ramped up - as did the penalties. CJS Olympiens took two in a row, firstly to #3 Naomie Bérubé for body checking and then to #29 Cami Daeninck for hooking, but CJS goaltender Chanelle Vandal stood tall. As the period wound down, the Clippers tried to make the 1-0 lead stand up. The Olympiens pressed hard, finally forcing Keyanna Lea to take a tripping penalty with 55 seconds left. The Olympiens pulled their goalie, but the Clippers' goalie, Jaidyn Crosby, was not to be denied. Crosby stood firm to preserve the shutout and the 1-0 game for the Clippers, forcing a third and deciding game in the series. Shots on goal in the third: Kelvin Clippers 12 for a three period total of 23, CJS Olympiens 6 for a three period total of 17.
