GOALTENDER EQUIPMENT

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Young players often share the goaltending duties on a team or wish to try the position for a short period before committing to the role on a full-time basis. The Association maintains a limited supply of goaltender equipment which may be made available to beginner goaltenders, upon request from a coach. It is assumed that goaltenders will acquire their own equipment once they have committed to the position on a full-time basis. This statement is intended to describe the policies and procedures relating to the use of Association equipment.

2.0 INVENTORY

The Association current has a limited number of complete sets of goaltender equipment which are suitable for Novice or Atom aged players. It also has additional sets of pads which would be appropriate for older goaltenders. The Association will consider purchasing specific pieces of equipment if they are required to complete a set.

3.0 REQUESTING EQUIPMENT

The appropriate coach should solicit the required equipment from the Equipment Manager(s). The coach will be required to "sign-out" the equipment at the beginning of the season and return it to the Equipment Manager(s) at the end of the season.

4.0 CUSTODY OF THE EQUIPMENT

The coach is expected to maintain custody of the equipment throughout the season and to return it to the storage locker at the end of each session.
