

OGHA: The COVID Challenges - Knowns

- Ice Contracts Richcraft SP, Carleton, City*
 - City Ice Allocation depends on many issues !!!
 - Standardized Ice *should* be avail from Oct Mar 2021
- # of players / ice surface: 25
- OGHA Registration #s Numbers
 - FUNdamentals, HL and Comp programs will ALL run
- No Tryouts, Games or Tournaments
 - All on-ice sessions will require physical distancing
- OGHA must screen and log each time a member participates in any OGHA activity

Public Health Protocols

- Players must arrive at rink fully dressed;
- Players can be walked to the door BUT parents not allowed to enter facility.
- For younger cohorts parent volunteers will be assigned, if required
- City of Ottawa is not allowing any spectators in their facilities.
- Face coverings must be worn in all public spaces in facilities including non-players who are on the bench.
- Masks will not be required on the ice or when players are on the bench

OGHA RTP Proposal

- Proposed Season DRAFT
 - ITR Comp \rightarrow post-Labour Day (3x / wk)
 - ITR HL/FUNdamentals \rightarrow October (HL: 2x/wk / FUN: 1x/wk)
 - Session #1 : Sept (or Oct) Dec
 - Session #2 : Jan 2020 TBD;
- Cohorts of 25 (max) will be formed taking into consideration age and skill level by coaches and Exec members players & coaches.
- Trainers are mandatory at every ice time.
- Jerseys and socks will not be provided. Players will be asked to bring a light and a dark jersey to their ice times.
- No team fees collected for session 1 although there will be additional fees for some competitive cohorts.


