To all NB Ringette teams and associations:

The Moncton Ringette Association (MRA) is proud to host the New Brunswick Ringette Provincial Jamboree and Tournament from Thursday, March 13th to Sunday, March 16th for divisions FUN2 to U16/19 and Open 18+. We are looking forward to filling the Greenfoot Energy 4-plex with exciting ringette all weekend.

On behalf of MRA, the Tournament Committee and the City of Moncton, I want to extend a warm invitation to Moncton!

**Tournament Logistics:**

- All Games will be played at the Greenfoot Energy 4-plex (Previously named the Superior Propane Centre).
- FUN2 games will have 4 teams on the ice at once, playing two half ice games in the one-hour slot. Teams marked as “Visitor” will switch sides after the first game. Teams will be sharing the dressing room, so we ask only 1 parent enter the dressing room with the athlete.
- U10 is full ice, jamboree format with no playoffs.
- There will be 2 banners awarded in each of the U12, U16/19 and Open divisions due to the overall # of participating teams. (Green and Maroon divisions)
- There will be Tier 1 divisions at U12 and U14.
- MRA will have volunteers performing Timekeeper and Scorekeeper roles for all round robin/regular games and playoff games. Anyone interested in volunteering, please contact [admin@monctonringette.com](mailto:admin@monctonringette.com) for the volunteer sign up link.
- For the U12, U14, U16/19 and Open divisions, the team listed as home on the schedule are required to provide a shot clock operator during the Round Robin/Regular games. RNB will schedule shot clock operators for all playoff games.
- Teams that require a separate dressing room for males players, please advise the volunteers at the Welcome Desk and they will advise you which room is designated for males.
- Local teams may be scheduled for Thursday evening games. All other teams must be prepared to play as early as 8am on Friday morning.

During the tournament, representatives from the host committee will be in the Tournament office to answer any questions you may have. This is located upstairs in the meeting rooms. Volunteers will also be clearly identified throughout the event.

All teams must sign-in to the Welcome Office (ticket office in the lobby) no later than 30 minutes prior to their game to get dressing room assignment and verify gamesheets (app). This is also where Shot Clock remotes will be signed out and the tournament Lost and Found.

Players should be ready to play 15 minutes before scheduled game times.

Upon initial sign-in, a team representative must sign a copy of the tournament rules and will be given their team manager bag with some goodies.

Player of the Game awards will be presented on ice during round robin games only. Coaches must be prepared to provide the player's name to the official so it can be announced and presented.

Coaches are not permitted on ice during the handshake unless they are wearing a helmet. (City of Moncton rules).

Please do not leave gear bags in hallways. Gear overflow will be under the stairs in Rink A ice level. Bags may not be left in any other hallway or lobby.
