Nothing yet from ND but this may yet come down from the League • No fundraising by Cadets or Adult Staff members. • All training will be conducted by adhering to the strictest guidelines: Masks will be worn- provided by DND. Social distancing. Hallway traffic will be directional. • No flying or gliding until at least the Spring

She is awaiting a response and was reassured that they had supported Cadets in the past.</p> <p>Beaumont Lion’s Club Bingos- We will continue to provide workers for their Bingos. This allows the Lion’s Club Members, many of whom are seniors, to remain somewhat safer during the Bingos. They in turn are incredibly pleased to provide our Squadron with a donation. We are only allowed 15 minutes prior to our rental time and must leave 15 minutes after so that the facility can be cleaned.
