

Letter from your Squadron Sponsoring Committee (SSC) September 2024

We extend a welcome back to all our previous air cadet families, and a warm welcome to our new ones!

RETURNING CADETS: Wednesday September 4, 2024 7:00-9:00 PM (1900-2100 hr)

The first night back for RETURNING cadets is Wednesday September 4th. This night, parents are asked to come with their cadets to complete mandatory paperwork as per Capt. Robinsons' instructions posted on the http://www.287aircadets.ca/

NEW AND TRANSFERRING IN CADETS: Wednesday September 11, 2024 7:00-9:00 PM (1900 -2100 hr)

The first night back for cadets new to 287 Squadron is Wednesday September 11th. This night, parents are asked to come with their cadets to complete mandatory paperwork as per Capt. Robinsons' instructions posted on the http://www.287aircadets.ca/

The Air Cadet program provides young Canadians ages 12 to 18 the opportunity to participate in a variety of fun, challenging, and rewarding activities and learn valuable life and work skills such as teamwork, leadership, and citizenship. Air Cadets learn about aviation technologies, air crew survival and how to fly and members of the Air Cadet Program will be given opportunities to fly in an airplane or glider during their time with the cadets.

PROGRAM COSTS:

The Department of National Defence, in partnership with the Air Cadet League of Canada, sponsors the costs associated with the fundamental programming and uniforms, however there are other costs which are not funded or fully funded. (2024/25 unfunded costs = approximately \$29,125)

Some of these include:

- Facility Rental and storage costs (approximately \$18,000 annually)
- Mess dinner (a time honored military tradition),
- Familiarization flying (powered aircraft flights), and
- Gliding.

So how do we fund this shortfall? Through volunteer opportunities and fundraising.

VOLUNTEER AND FUNDRAISING:

In order to provide our cadets with a more robust program and keep the program cost-free and accessible to all families, the SSC (also known as the parent committee) has a variety of ways that we can ensure that we raise the money to help pay for those additional costs that are *not* covered for by the military and the league.

Volunteer bonds are pre-payments that families provide that are returned in exchange for participation in volunteer activities. The purpose of the volunteer bond is to encourage families to support the squadron with the fundraising initiatives throughout the year to help raise funds that directly benefit the cadets. The volunteer bond **is not** a fundraising initiative for the squadron. Volunteering to help the squadron serves a greater value than the cash value of the bond and we would like as many families to help out as much as possible throughout the year.

We are asking each family to provide three \$100 volunteer bond payments. Cash is preferred but three post-dated cheques in the amount of \$100 each, made payable to" 287 Beaumont Air Cadet Squadron Sponsoring Committee", dated May 31, 2025 are also acceptable. Please ensure you include your cadet(s)' name in the memo section of the cheque. Please note that if a family has more than one cadet in the squadron, only one set of volunteer bonds is required per family.

For each volunteer activity you participate in, one volunteer bond payment will be returned to you (or shredded depending upon your indicated preference) up to a total of three.

FUNDRAISING SCHEDULE:
