# **Coaching Registration/Certification Info Sheet**

### Important info before you get started:

*Certified coaches at all levels* receive a Bisons hat at no charge. If you received one a few years ago and your current hat has faded just let me know and we'll refresh your look. Rally Cap and Grand Slam head coaches get a Bisons hat for free.

AMB is using an e-store for apparel and coaches in the competitive program (11u to 18u) receive the following:

- Head coaches \$100 discount code
- Assistant coaches \$50 discount code

Discount codes will be provided at a later date once the e-store is open. All coaches need to wear white baseball pants with a blue top of some kind as a part of our uniform. There are a variety of coaches shirts and jackets to choose from.

If you do not have white baseball pants, we have a 20% off coupon you can use at Time Out Sports in Winkler.

All course fees are reimbursed – send receipts to <u>altonaminorbaseball@gmail.com</u> and an etransfer will be sent back to that email address.

#### \*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\*

In order to complete your registration online you will need to have your Respect In Sport (RIS) number handy. If you haven't completed your RIS certification you can take here <u>Respect In Sport Link</u>.

You will also need to have registered with NCCP here <u>NCCP Registration Link</u>. There is a fee for this but AMB will reimburse you.

## All Coaches – For anyone who wants to be on the bench

**1)** Register yourself in RAMP as staff - <u>AMB Registration Link</u> Please be sure to complete the screening disclosure form and upload it when registering.

2) Have your RIS number handy to input (<u>Respect In Sport Link</u>)

**3)** Register an account through Baseball Canada NCCP - <u>NCCP Registration Link</u>. There is a fee for this. Once registered in NCCP you will be able to sign up for the required courses.

- a. Coach Initiation in Sport (Online)
- b. Coach Initiation in Baseball Fundamentals (Online)
- c. Rule of 2 Online Module <u>Rule of 2 eLearning Module</u> (Click on **Take the eLearning Module** to sign in and start the course)

Note: When you open the Rule of 2 eLearning Module link, you should then click on "Take the eLearning Module". You'll be asked login with your NCCP account details. Once the next page opens go to the middle column of courses shown and at the very bottom is the "Understand the Rule of Two". Click on that and then on the right some details of the course will show up to read, at the bottom will be a button to hit and begin the course.

All head & assistant coaches need to complete the above training to be certified for league play, playoffs, and provincial tournaments. **This also applies to Rally Cap and Grand Slam coaches**.

### Head Coach Requirement Only – 11u to 18u

**4)** Complete the in-person **Initiation Coach Clinic** – hosted in Altona on Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup>. Register by contacting Baseball MB - <u>Initiation Coach Clinic Registration Link</u> Grand Slam coaches are also welcome to take the course – especially if they are planning on coaching in 11u.

**5)** For **11U and 13U coaches** you also need to complete the **My First Pitch** (online) training. There is a fee for this module and it can be accessed through your NCCP account.
