

Arnprior McNab Ringette Equipment Policy

Please provide a \$150 Deposit Cheque Dated April 1^{st.} This will be returned to you provided all equipment is returned in good condition at the end of the season.

- 1. The Arnprior McNab Ringette Association jerseys/equipment are on loan for the season and will be collected at the end of the season. The player is responsible for any loss or damage to the jersey/equipment (excluding normal wear).
- 2. When putting on any name bars consider how they will be removed at the end of the season. Arnprior McNab Ringette Association recommends hand-stitching of name bars to minimize damage to the jerseys. Name bars must be positioned on the upper shoulder area of the jersey.
- 3. Nothing other than name bars are to be attached to the jerseys without written permission from the AMRA executive.
- 4. The jerseys are to be worn for games only. Each player should have her own practice jersey for practices.
- 5. In order to protect the jerseys, players are to bring their game jerseys to the arena on a hanger and in a garment bag.
- 6. The jerseys should be aired out after each game and never put in the dryer.
- 7. When the jerseys are returned the manager will inspect the jerseys/equipment for any damage. In the event that the jerseys/equipment have been damaged the manager will consult with the equipment coordinator and executive, to determine if charges will apply.
