- Report to U14 Head Coach and Executive Director
- Attend mandatory staff training, complete modules to ensure a licensed status
- Works alongside Head Coach for appropriate skill development in Learn to Train model
- Course setting, video and athlete management experience
- Ensure safe training, racing and mountain environments at all times
- Provide a strong ski example for athletes both in race environments and technical free skiing
- Ability to carry gates, knowledge on b-net, equipment maintenance
- Follow and acknowledge Club policies, Safe Sport, Responsible coaching and implement Club Emergency Action Plan
- Helmets are mandatory
- Team Jackets provided

Entry Level Coach Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Minimum 3+ years coaching experience
- Minimum Development Level trained, ideally DL certified
- Team player and gets along well with others and can communicate with teammates
- Ability to take direction, manage multiple tasks and function independently
- Communicate well with children and can pass on feedback to parents
- High energy, resilience, professionalism, willing to continue your coaching education
- Past alpine racer FIS and higher considered an asset
- Must have a Canadian work visa, accommodation not provided.
