- Tryouts:

- Scheduling:
  - Chinook Ringette League has eliminated interdivisional play for north and south U14/U16 teams. Ringette Calgary and AA Ringette Calgary are working together with Ringette Alberta to find solutions.
- Ringette Calgary:
  - Referees will be wearing mics this season; Brad has contacted refs to ensure we are onside and connected.
- Sponsorship:
  - There is an opportunity to look at modernizing AA team broadcasts in conjunction with RAB. This could be a potential opportunity for sponsorship.
- Strategic Plan:
  - The board met to complete work around a new mission statement, the individualization
    of programming for each age group, partnering with Rath for development opportunities,
    and bringing in avoidance and impact absorption training to work with U16/U19 to learn
    to avoid contact and prevent injury.
- Word Ringette Championships 2027:
  - AA Ringette Calgary put forward a bid. It was shortlisted and Dieppe was chosen to host.

  - To help the new AA league be the best in the country, and have a forward thinking agenda driving the narrative.

### AA Ringette Calgary Report to Ringette Calgary for the 2024-2025 Season

Following team selection and season start up activities, our association continued the tradition of participating as Team Jenna in the Ovarian Cancer Walk of Hope. This event has become a staple for the ringette community and we remain proud to be part of it.

AA Ringette Calgary hosted the Ring It On Tournament in September at the Great Plains Arena, which was a great success. We also hosted a new tournament in January that we have high hopes with. Several of our association's athletes participated in La Releve and various other invitational tournaments around the world.

At the wonderful year end banquet and gala, Brynn Tarnowsky was honoured with the Jenna Sauer Spirit in Coaching Award, and Caley Minault was recognized with the AA Ringette Calgary Service Award in addition to becoming a new mom this fall!

One of our beloved AA players was struck with Cancer this season. The Canadian Ringette Community showed it's incredible power raising over 100,000 dollars in support and the player's #12 helmet sticker was worn by dozens of teams across the country. It has been an incredibly emotional journey for the family and the broader ringette community. The support is deeply appreciated.

Our teams had exceptional success on the ice this season. In addition to many tournament victories, including AA Ringette Calgary teams U16 Fuze, taking home Gold and U16AA Team Edge Silver in Esso Golden Ring. We would like to specifically recognize the following post-season accomplishments:

There are 4 Canadian Cities short listed for hosting, including Calgary. At the time of this report, the successful bid has not been announced. We look forward to hopefully sharing exciting news in the near future.

The AA Ringette Calgary board recently met to begin the process of creating a new mission statement for the organization. We also held a strategic planning session to help identify how we integrate into Ringette in Alberta. Age group specific opportunities for development were explored. We identified areas of coach development, skill development, personal development, injury prevention/management, mentorship opportunities, and others. The outcomes included concerted efforts to better align and resource Ringette Calgary Associations in athlete identification, recruitment, and development. The board is excited about the outcomes of these sessions and looks forward to sharing more information in the coming months.
