AA Ringette Calgary Report to Ringette Calgary for the 2023-2024 Season

Following team selection and season start up activities, our association continued the tradition of participating as Team Jenna in the Ovarian Cancer Walk of Hope, and this year we were joined by athletes from Zone 2 AA Ringette. We had the opportunity to showcase our association through the creation of a promotional video and photos in a partnership with TeamTown Sports.

AA Ringette Calgary hosted the Ring It On Tournament September 22-24 at the Great Plains Arena, along with an association-wide season kick off party called the Ring It On RIOT. Several of our association's athletes participated in the World Ringette Championships held in Calgary from October 29 to November 4, 2023, and the Ringette Canada events La Releve and the first international U18 Development Camp preceding the start of WRCs. As an association we cheered Team Canada Junior to their Silver medal. With tournament ice available in November, we hosted the first U19AA Black Gold League hub weekend, although it required bringing in referees from north and central zones as well as from Saskatchewan to cover all games.

Based on injury data collected in partnership with the Sport Injury and Prevention Research Centre at the University of Calgary over the past two seasons, the AA Committee passed a motion mandating shoulder pad use beginning in August 2024.

At the wonderful year end banquet and gala, Rachael McKerracher was honoured with the Jenna Sauer Spirit in Coaching Award, and Leigh Sauer was recognized with the AA Ringette Calgary Service Award.

Our teams had exceptional success on the ice this season. In addition to many tournament victories, including AA Ringette Calgary teams taking home Gold in all age divisions from the premier tournaments Wood and Esso Golden Ring, we would like to specifically recognize the following post-season accomplishments:

Provincials:

- U14AA: Bronze Team Blue
- U16AA: Gold Team Strike; Silver Team Attack
- U19AA: Gold Team Combat; Silver Team CREW

Western Canadian Ringette Championships:

- U14AA: Team Blue 4th
- Sophia Meyer was named to the All-Star team, and Avery Ashley won for fastest skater in the skills competition. As well, Team Attack coach and alumni Shyla Bruvall was named to the Open A All-Star team.

Canadian Ringette Championships:

- U16AA: Silver Team Strike (as Team Alberta); Team Peak 4 th; Team Attack 5 th
 - In the skills competition, top 3 finishers included Tasha Blackwell and Arianna Draper for fastest skater, Sophia Coli for goalie agility, and Addison Jozsa for accuracy shooting.
 - All-Star team members: 1 st line Tasha Blackwell and Brooke Rolles, 2 nd line Jocelyne Galbraith,
 Jadee Patel and Sophia Coli
- U19AA: Gold Team Combat (as Team Alberta); Team CREW 4th
 - In the skills competition, top 3 finishers included Sage Snethun for fastest skater, Reagan Hatch for goalie agility and Dani Falconer for hardest shot.



- All-Star team members: 1 st line Sage Snethun, Lauren Schoenhofen and Kaylee Armstrong; 2 nd line Ashley Anderson and Reagan Hatch
- NRL: Silver Calgary RATH
 - RATH coaches Barb Bautista, Chelsea Butt, Dallas Robbins, Paul Geddes and Jeff Ung won the NRL Coaching Staff of the Year award, and Kaitlyn Youldon was named as Most Valuable Player in the NRL. Cayleigh Hassell was named as the 2 nd line all-star defence for her CRC performance.

As a Board we will work to identify novel opportunities for athlete and coach development so as to ensure the continued success of the AA Ringette Calgary program.
