- 4) 2023/24 Committee Reports
 - President (Cheryl B.)
 - Reminders to teams:
 - teams reps Please ensure you are attending the committee meetings to ensure we have quorum and also to report back to your teams with important / timely information.
 - respectful behaviour Please be respectful at tournaments and remember you are representing our association. We received complaints from a hotel and bus vendor about a team's behaviour during a recent tournament. This damages our reputation and relationships with contacts.
 - mandatory apparel Please respect the Calgary AA mandatory apparel for wearing to games (Red jacket, grey AA hoodie, black pants/shorts). We have received some comments from others and also observed some players not following the dress code.
 - Tournament success: We would like to acknowledge and celebrate all our teams that have participated in tournaments recently.
 - Regina U16AA Strike won gold
 - Saskatoon U16AA Attack won gold, U16AA Peak won consolation final (5th); U14AA White won gold, U14AA Blue won B-consolation (7th), U14AA Red won C-final (9th)
 - Ringette Calgary updates
 - Hitmen game Dec 6 in support of Ringette for All will receive \$5 from every ticket purchased through the specific link
 - CRL game schedules should be released approx Nov 28/30; then will need to wait a few days for the BGL game schedule to be released at which time there may be a few adjustments; we should have final schedules by approx Dec 3
 - Refs CRL and other regions continue to be short on high level refs and working toward developing. (ie. We had to bring in refs from Edm, Central and Sask for our Nov Hub weekend due to it being a high demand weekend with Leth tournament, NRL hub, and



CRL league games. Good news - one of those refs earned a higher certification due to her games that weekend.) Please be aware when scheduling exhibition games to aim for during the week rather than weekends which tend to have high demand on ref assigning.

Hub weekend

- u19s good feedback from u19s for BGL league games; north teams were happy that it wasn't a tournament format which would have required extra hotel costs and fees
- u16s heard good feedback on fitting in many exhibition games, particularly those teams who haven't had many tournaments yet; acknowledge it has been a lot of ice this fall
- ice / ref costs we'll review the final costs at a later meeting once the ice invoices and other costs are all in; some costs will be recouped from Z2 and other teams that were here for league / exh games; approx 9 slots on Fri am that were unused will be covered by RCalgary to ensure the ice contract is retained for next season.

Team Town Sports

- donation received from the film promo they completed featuring our u19s
- requested assistance from our association for a couple contacts to advise on their merchandise in exchange for a donation / gift cards; we passed it along to RATH
- offering an AA exclusive shopping night 30% off footwear and apparel; 20% off hard goods; will find a night that works with schedules and provide more information

• **VP League** (Heather H.) - report submitted

- Advance / Retreat meetings currently attending these meetings; there aren't any changes that will
 affect our teams which means the total number of AA teams in Alberta will remain:
 - 9 teams at u14aa
 - 9 teams at u16aa
 - 7 teams at u19aa
 - this means all AA teams get to participate in provincials; no need for a "session 3" playdown format
- RAMP gamesheets please ensure you are entering names of the minor officials and on-ice officials (found in the last tab)

Ice Allocation

- Dec game schedule expected approx Nov 27/30 for CRL at which time we can finish the practice ice allocations for Dec; may need to adjust a few ice times once BGL schedule released a few days later but everyone should know their final schedules by Dec 3
- Dec 23-Jan 2 each team will get 1-2 full ice practices during this time; usually coaches decide if these are optional but connect with your coach for expectations



- Winsport ice the early ice times will continue in the new year; distribution will be evened out as we move through the season; we know the early times are challenging but it is important to take ice contracts where we can and also build relationships with providers.
- U14 Blue and White took some of the additional ice that was available at Winsport during WRCs; those invoices will come directly to your teams rather than through AA
