There is no additional fee required to participate in these sessions, but all players must register via RAMP (for both the Conditioning Sessions and the 2023-24 Season) no later than August 16, 2023.

CRGHA and Safeguard by Phil Martin are bringing the NHL/NHLPA First Shift Program to Clarence-Rockland! This program is designed for those new to hockey and includes six instructor led sessions and a full set of Bauer equipment for all participants. The program is kicked off with an exciting Welcome Event that hosts Bauer representatives and welcomes all participants to be personally fitted for their equipment. Our program is open to girls ages 5-12 and will run from **November 5 – December 15.** This is a great opportunity for girls new to the sport to try it out!

CRGHA continues to make arrangements for the implementation of the 2023-24 competitive program. All competitive teams level B, BB, A or AA will participate in this program at an additional cost of \$300 per player. This additional fee will be charged prior to the start of the season, once rosters are finalized and go towards additional ice time and development. As part of the program, we will also be implementing the equipment changes to these teams as established by the CRGHA executive board in 2021, which identified two years as a transition period. Effective this season, all competitive teams level B and up will be required to wear:

- Black Lightning track suits (CX Model)
- Lightning pant shells
- Black helmets
- Black gloves
