CODE OF CONDUCT

A Code of Conduct is a set of rules outlining the social norms, responsibilities of, or proper practices for team officials, players, parents, guardians and spectators to ensure soccer is a fun, safe, and positive experience for all. It is a condition that all participants read and agree to always abide by the Code of Conduct.

CDSA - COACH CODE OF CONDUCT

 \checkmark Consistently display the highest standards of behavior and be a positive role model.

 \checkmark Never engage in public criticism of anyone in any situation on or off the field.

 \checkmark Place well-being and safety above all other considerations, including performance and results.

 \checkmark Coaches will attempt to develop all players on a team or in a player pool.

 \checkmark Coaches will not use vulgar or profane language at games or practices.

 \checkmark Coaches are to arrive on time and be fully prepared for all games and practices.

 \checkmark Coaches will teach players to play fairly and to respect the rules, referees, opponents, and spectators.

 \checkmark Ensure players, staff, and spectators respect the field boundaries for training and match play.

 \checkmark Ensure that all coaches adhere to the Rule of Two (at least two adults present) when interacting with minors on and off the field.

✓ Ensure all digital communication between players and coaches must take place on designated Club platforms and must always adhere to the rule of 2 (no 1-1 communication). Communication between coaches and players using personal social media or digital channels is not permitted.

 \checkmark Coaches will ensure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the players' ages and abilities.

 \checkmark Show zero tolerance for offensive language, behaviour or any form of bullying.

 \checkmark Inform parents of any injuries their child might have suffered without delay.

 \checkmark Coaches will never take part in a practice, game or team event while under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.

 \checkmark Coaches will not smoke at games or practices

 \checkmark Coaches will dress appropriately in approved Club wear for all games and practices.

 \checkmark Coaches are responsible for the payment of any fine imposed on the Club by a league or by ASA that is a consequence of their behavior

 \checkmark Adhere to ASA Code of Conduct – ALBERTA SOCCER ASSOCIATION – Code of Conduct and Ethics

 \checkmark Participate only in ASA Sanctioned Events.

CDSA PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

 \checkmark Players will not use vulgar or profane language at games or practices.

 \checkmark Not engage in negative comments towards players or teams through any social media platforms.

 \checkmark Players are to arrive on time and be fully prepared for all games and practices.

✓ Ensure all digital communication between players and coaches must take place on designated Club platforms and must always adhere to the rule of 2 (no 1-1 communication). Communication between coaches and players using personal social media or digital channels is not permitted.

 \checkmark Players will never take part in a practice, game or team event while under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.

 \checkmark Players will dress appropriately in approved Club wear for all games and practices.

CDSA PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

 \checkmark Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectator Area.

 \checkmark Refrain from yelling or coaching from the sidelines during training sessions or games.

 \checkmark Parents are to encourage Players at all games and practices and refrain from making negative comments.

 \checkmark Parents will never attend a practice, game or team event while under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.

 \checkmark Parents will not smoke at games or practices.

 \checkmark Parents are responsible for the payment of any fine imposed on the Club by a league or by ASA that is a consequence of their behavior.
