



## **CORNWALL GIRLS HOCKEY ASSOCIATION SUZANNE HICKLEY BURSARY**

The Suzanne Hickley award is presently annually to a graduating or senior member of the Cornwall Girls Hockey Association who demonstrates outstanding community involvement as well as strong dedication to the continued growth of girls hockey.

This award is named after Suzanne Hickley, a mother of twin girls who played hockey for the CGHA. A diagnosis of breast cancer was not enough to keep Suzanne from supporting her daughters at the rink or in the community. Her quiet demeanor and contagious smile was always present. Suzanne was an example of one who never put her life on hold despite the presence of cancer. She was a true inspiration to all who knew her. This bursary will be presented annually to a female player who is in her final year of secondary education and will be entering a post secondary institution. The bursary is a one-time award of **\$750.00** provided by the CGHA.

The following criteria will apply in selecting a nominee for the award.

1. Preference will be given to a graduating or senior player
2. Involvement as a volunteer in girls hockey and the community
3. Displays the qualities of
  - a) Perseverance
  - b) Dedication
  - c) Leadership
  - d) Sportsmanship
  - e) Courage and Determination

### **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible the nominee must:

- be a registered member of the OWH and CGHA during the past year and is a member in good standing within the association;
- have played within the CGHA during the last three years;
- be in a position in her education to be eligible to attend a post secondary education.



## HOW TO APPLY

Application forms will be made available online - March 31st is the application deadline. Applications received after March 31st will not be accepted. Nominations may be submitted by the player or anyone familiar with the player.

To register a nominee, the following must be submitted along with the application form:

- one letter from the association registrar attesting to the nominee's good standing within the association.
- one letter of acceptance from a post secondary school.
- one letter of reference from a member of the community with focus on volunteering - CGHA and/or community.
