



Job Title: Day Camp Leader
Anticipated Start Date: End of June

Under the supervision of the Coordinator and Sports and Recreation Leaders, Day Camp Leaders are responsible for the safe delivery of all summer canoe, kayak, and related paddling programs. They help organize and lead a variety of small and large group land and water-based activities, involving canoe and kayak instruction. They work together toward a deeper understanding of leadership and counseling skills.

General Responsibilities:

- Lead a variety of small and large group activities each week.
- Know and understand all emergency procedures associated with on and off water activities.
- Maintain constant surveillance of the dock and water.
- They ensure that the campers understand and are compliant with all safety instructions, and in the care of club equipment.
- They ensure that the dock is kept clean and organized.
- They know, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines associated with the camp and all program areas, including but not limited to, being responsible for campers' safety and whereabouts at all times.
- Day Camp Leaders are responsible for making Summer Camp a fun and safe learning environment.
- Ensure that Campers are being included in all games and activities (on and off the water).
- Responsible for all other Camp necessities (ie. Set-Up and Take Down) and help run the Camp to ensure the week goes smoothly.

Requirements:

- Must be willing to attain Canoe Kids training, Basic First Aid Certification, and a Transport Canada approved Pleasure Craft Operators Card.
- Must be willing to be a team player and support fellow coaches and leaders.
