## GGHA 2025-26 Season - Rep Team Tryout Info

1. Registration

- **Online Registration Required:** All players must be registered online prior to the start of tryouts.
- Registration Link: <u>http://glengarrygha.rampregistrations.com/</u>
- Registration Opens: March 25

# 2. Tryout Fees

- Cost: \$75 per level
  - This includes two guaranteed ice times.
  - No refunds will be issued for tryouts.
- Payment Details:
  - A **\$75 fee is required for each level** a player is trying out for.
  - Example: If trying out for both U15 and U18, the total fee is \$150.
  - This fee covers ice time for two guaranteed tryout sessions per level.
  - Multiple Level Tryouts: The \$75 fee applies per level.
- Payment Method:
  - Fees must be paid in full before stepping on the ice.

## 3. Attendance Expectations & Eligibility

- All players interested in joining a GGHA rep team are expected to **fully attend and participate** in scheduled tryouts.
- If a player cannot attend any tryout session due to **injury**, **illness**, or other reasons, the **GGHA board must be contacted in advance**.
- Tier Requirements:
  - Players are **not required to try out for a higher tier** (e.g., B) to be eligible for a lower tier (e.g., C).
  - Players may try out directly for the tier they are interested in.
- Playing Up an Age Group:
  - Players may try out for one age group above their current level (e.g., U15 player trying out for U18).
  - This is permitted due to the small size of the association and to accommodate elite players in appropriate levels.

## 4. Releases & Player Movement

- Releases may begin after the second tryout session, based on evaluator feedback • and at the discretion of the GGHA board.
- Post-Tryout #1 Removal:
  - The board may remove a player after the first tryout if it is determined they are 0 not at the appropriate competitive level.
  - A full refund will be issued in this case.
- **Exclusion from Future Sessions:** 
  - Independent evaluators may exclude certain players from Tryout #2 or #3.
  - This decision is based on optimizing evaluation—not an indication that the player 0 has been released or selected.
  - This helps reduce the number of participants for more effective evaluation.
  - No refunds for missed or excluded sessions, as only two sessions are guaranteed.

## 5. Out-of-Association Players

- Players from outside GGHA must either:
  - Provide a Permission to Tryout 0 OR
  - Request a release from their home club
- Note: GGHA cannot issue or process releases from other associations.

#### Exceptions (No Release Required):

- A) Players transferring from a coed organization (e.g., Alexandria, EPR, NGS minor hockey) and who have never registered with OWHA.
- B) Players registering with OWHA for the first time.
- Important:

Players in scenarios A or B must temporarily register with GGHA for insurance coverage during tryouts and exhibition games.

There is no additional fee for this temporary registration. 0

## 8. Tryout Process & Team Selection

- Independent evaluators will assess all players during tryouts.
- By the end of the third session, they will identify:
  - The top 8 players
  - Four bubble players
- Coach interviews will take place 2–3 days after the third tryout session (see *Coach Interview Dates* below).
- A head coach will be selected within 24 hours after interviews are completed.

The appointed head coach will then:

- Select 2 of the 4 bubble players to complete the initial roster
- Identify **2 additional players** (from tryouts) as potential team members

These additional players will be placed **on hold** until final roster numbers are confirmed in **August**. They are also encouraged to attend tryouts for other appropriate levels (e.g., **U18C**) to increase their placement opportunities.

## **U18B Exception**

An exception has been granted for **two players at the U18B level** who were among the **top five players** from the 2024–25 team.

Due to unavoidable circumstances:

- These players will **miss the first two tryouts**
- They may also miss the **third session**, though efforts will be made to have them attend

To ensure fairness:

- Six bubble players will be identified for U18B, including the two absent players
- Based on their **past performance** and **commitment** to the association, the board feels they deserve a fair chance

The tentative U18B roster of 10 players is expected to be announced following the exhibition game on May 11

## 9. Tryout Format

- A combination of **skill sessions** and **scrimmages/exhibition games** will be used throughout the tryout sessions.
- Additional practice or exhibition games may be required to finalize team selection.
  - These will not result in additional tryout fees.

### 10. Season Expectations & Fees

- For the **2025–26 season**, an additional **rep fee of up to \$275** may be charged to cover increased ice time requirements as determined by the coach and team.
  - If applicable, this fee is due **before the team's first regular ice time**.
- Travel Expectations:
  - Rep teams compete in the **Greater Eastern Ontario area** and occasionally in **Gatineau**.
  - Teams should be prepared to travel for games on **weekends and weekdays** to locations such as:
    - Brockville
    - Smiths Falls
    - Carleton Place
    - Ottawa, etc.
- Additional Team Fees:

- May apply to cover tournament participation and other team-related costs.
- Final team fees will be set by the **coach/team** once tournament schedules are confirmed.

#### 11. Player Evaluation Criteria

#### Skaters Will Be Assessed On:

- Skating ability
- Passing accuracy and technique
- Puck control
- Shooting skills
- Overall gameplay performance
- Hockey IQ during scrimmages

#### Goalies Will Be Assessed On:

- Positioning and stance
- Reflexes and reaction time
- Puck handling
- Save techniques
- Game performance
- Ability to read plays and anticipate action

### 12. Notification & Feedback

- All players will be notified of their tryout results by **blind-copied email** within **one week of the final tryout session (Tryout #3)**, unless extenuating circumstances cause a delay.
  - Please check your junk/spam folder, as emails may be filtered there.
- 24-Hour Rule:
  - Parents/guardians must wait 24 hours after the announcement before contacting the board.
- Feedback Exchange:
  - On the second day after announcements, parents may email ggha\_president@hotmail.com to request a feedback meeting.
  - This meeting will be held within one week of the request and will include:
    - GGHA board members
    - The player
    - A parent or guardian
    - One neutral observer to facilitate the conversation
