- Glengarry GHA will host Rep Teams at U13, U15 and U18 for the 2024-2025 season
- Final level and number of teams will depend on outcome of tryouts
- Players must be registered prior to tryout online. Please complete registration on RAMP:

- Cost of tryouts is \$75. This includes up to 3 ice times. There will be no refunds for tryouts.
- Fees must be paid in full before a player steps on the ice
 - Fees can be paid in full by May 9th by E-transfer to glengarrygha@hotmail.com
- It is expected that players wishing to play for a GGHA rep team attend and fully participate in all tryouts held for that team. Any player unable to attend tryouts due to injury, illness or any reason must contact the GGHA board prior to the tryout.
- Players from other associations must provide a (Permission to PTT) PTT before tryouts

 - A release or PTT is not required for Players who are transferring from an unisex organization AND never registered with OWHA or players who are registering with OWHA for the first time.

Team Information

- All chosen players for our U18, U15 & U13 Competitive teams will be expected to pay an up-charge of a *minimum* of \$225. This up-charge will go towards team costs for practice time and games as necessary. The actual amount will be determined in August.
