

## 2024–2025 HHRA Registrar: Annual Report

It was another season of growth for the Halifax Hurricanes. Overall registration numbers saw an increase of 17%, as compared to the 2023-2024 season:

Other highlights from the season include:

- Splitting FUN1/FUN2 registration into 2 sessions over the regular season (fall and winter) proved to be very successful; 16 new players (in addition to those returning from the fall session) joined for the winter session.
- Increased registration was also experienced in the U10 division, with 13 brand new players joining. Most of these new players were enrolled in the Intro to Ringette program during the 2023-2024 season.
- Looking ahead to the 2025-2026 season, strong numbers can be expected for the U10, U12, and U19 divisions, with hopes of even more growth at the FUN1/FUN2 level.
- As previously discussed, projected registration numbers indicate that team formation may be challenging at the U14 and U16 levels for the upcoming season.
- Spring skating development sessions were very popular, and both age groups filled up quickly. Spring goalie development attracted goalies from other associations, with 17 of 25 spots filled.
- The U14 / U16 Summer Development program was full, with a waiting list, almost as soon as it was posted. Other summer development programs (skating and goalie) were recently activated and have seen moderate registration numbers so far.

On a personal note, over the past year – my first as Registrar - I've developed a solid understanding of the responsibilities involved with this role. I appreciate everyone who was helpful and patient as I learned. I am pleased to reoffer for the Registrar position for the upcoming 2025-2026 season.
