

2025–2026 HHRA Registrar: Annual Report

It was another season of growth for the Halifax Hurricanes Ringette Association. Overall registration numbers experienced a small increase, as compared to the 2024-2025 season:

Other highlights from the season include:

- Splitting FUN1/FUN2 registration into 2 sessions over the regular season (fall and winter) again proved to be very successful; 22 new players (in addition to those returning from the fall session) joined for the winter session.
- Registration numbers continue to bounce back in the junior divisions after the decline experienced during Covid. The U12 division experienced an 82% jump for the 2025-2026 season, resulting in the formation of 2 large teams.
- Looking ahead to the 2026-2027 season, strong numbers can once again be expected for the U10, U12, and U19 divisions, with hopes of even more growth at the FUN1/FUN2 level.
- Projected registration numbers indicate that team formation may be challenging at the U14 and U16 levels for the upcoming season.
- Winter and spring skating development sessions were popular within the association, with both age groups seeing strong numbers.
- Summer development programs have seen moderate registration numbers so far. These programs were recently opened to other associations.

I would like to thank all players, families, coaches, volunteers, and board members for their support throughout the season. Registration continued to run smoothly thanks to everyone's cooperation, communication, and patience. It has been a pleasure helping support another successful year for our association, and I look forward to building on these successes in the season ahead.
