2. Divisions and Competitive Ringette

U7/9 Fundamentals (FUN 1/2): Balanced teams on shared ice.

U10 and U12: Balanced teams playing games.

U14/U16/U19: Optional competitive tryouts (registration required) will result in one Tier 1 competitive team per division. Athletes who do not make a Tier 1 team, or who choose not to participate in tryouts, will be placed onto one or more balanced Tier 2 team(s).

Open (18+): Weekly games.

Masters: Weekly games.

3. Which Division should I register my athlete?

Registration is based on an athlete's birth year and age as of December 31, 2022.

Example 1: if your athlete is 11 years old today but will turn 12 on December 4th, 2022, they should be registered in U14 for the upcoming season.

Example 2: if your athlete is 11 years old today but will turn 12 on January 29th, 2023, they should be registered in U12 for the upcoming season.

4. Fees for Competitive Players

Each Association will have one Tier 1 team and one or more balanced Tier 2 teams within U14/U16/U19. Competitive fees (in addition to base registration fees) will be collected from U14/U16/U19 Tier 1 players once teams have been formed. Fees for Tier 1 teams as follows:

U14 T1 Competitive fee of \$300 (plus \$850 registration) = \$1150

U16 T1 Competitive fee of \$300 (plus \$850 registration) = \$1150

U19 T1: Competitive fee of \$425 (plus \$500 registration) = \$925
Goalie T1: Competitive fee of \$300 (plus \$475 registration) = \$775

5. Promotions and Discounts

HHRA is pleased to offer the following discounts. Please note that all players must be registered at the same time to utilize these codes. Only one code per family may be used (i.e., either Family Discount or New Player – but not both). If a promo code is used in error, the Registrar will reach out directly to balance the account prior to the start of season.

Family Discount (two players): \$50. Use Promo Code 'Family1'

Family Discount (three + players): \$100. Use Promo Code 'Family2'

New Player Discount: A New Player is someone registering in any division who has *never* registered for ringette before.

\$50.00. Use Promo Code 'NewPlayer'

6. Rafflebox 50/50

We were not able to add Rafflebox 50/50 credits directly to your profile as any of you have yet to create a RAMP account. 7. Payment Methods:

We are pleased to offer online credit card payment and E-Transfers. Payment may be made in full or in two installments with 50% due up front and the remainder due on October 1, 2022. Credit card installment payments will be processed automatically.

E-Transfers: should be sent to treasurer@hhringette.ca with password set to 'ringette'. Please include your player's first and last name and registered division in the comments section.

Credit Card: as with all vendors, there is an admin fee for credit card use. The fee charged by the registration app is 2.2%.

Should you have any questions about payment, please contact the Treasurer at treasurer@hhringette.ca. Please note that it's your responsibility to ensure that your payments are received by the Treasurer. If no payments or payment arrangements are received by October 1 of the registration year, your registration will be considered incomplete and may impact participation in the upcoming season.
