- 1. Call to order by Secretary Jaime Da Costa Meeting started at 6:40pm
- 2. Review Agenda Jaime Da Costa
- 3. Approval of last meeting minutes (vote) - Jaime Da Costa Adopted
- 4. Reports
 - a. President Danny Skene Successful season overall winning multiple banners in zones and regionals
 - b. R.I.S.E. Committee Proposal for RISE committee, to include President of SMRA and IRA who will be co-chairs. Also include Executive member of IRA and an executive member of SMRA. Also include a RISE liaison. Committee to be named by April 5th.
 - c. Evaluations Recap IRA 119 Athletes and 18 Ice times. RISE 161 Athletes, 32 Ice sessions. \$100 evaluation fee covered cost of outside evaluators.
 - d. Registrar Trevor Robinson 130 players and 11 teams. 2024-2025 team projections show 3-4 + CTR in AS, 24 in U10, 25 in U12, 24 in U14, 24 in U16 and 8 in U19
 - e. Vice President Blair Lillejord team recaps provided by coaches and managers, read by president Danny Skene.
 - f. Treasurer Alex Litwiller Reviewed prior season and current season projections. 2023/2024 Forecasted income of \$137K and expenses of \$154K. Projected 2024/2025 income is \$128K and expenses of \$155K. Budget approved by majority.
 - g. Coach & Player Development Jarrett Browne new this year of providing team budgets for player development instead of at the association level, positive feedback overall. Breakfast club pilot program, overall positive feedback however looking to include all teams next year. Also looking to move time as difficult for some to get to school. Goalie development also successful this year – included 4 breakfast club sessions and 3 Friday goalie only sessions. Come try goalie offered to Step 3 and U12.
 - Proposal put forward to cover a welcome jacket and 2 out of town tournament stays, max 3 nights of non-association enrolled athlete coaches. Motion put forward to cover these costs going forward, seconded and approved by majority. Proposal on mandating chest protectors at all age groups. Will table to get a clear description of the type of chest protector required.
 - h. Trip of the Month Vote Danny Skene Trip of the Month proposed as official 2024/2025 fundraiser. Voted in by majority.
 - i. Election of 2023/24 IRA Executive, Director & Volunteer Positions
