- 2. Provincials commitment to attend extended to Jan 15th Commitment to attend has been extended to January 15th. IRA will pay for half of session 3 and half of provincials cost.
- 3. U12 Regionals update Foothills looking to host U12C, however in desperate need of volunteers. IRA to cover 50% of cost.
