- iii. Treasurer's report Under budget for Year-end party
- iv. Evaluations update Looking to lower UAA scores to be weighted at 15% and scored scrimmage to 85% in order to better assess players and allow more movement in evaluation groups which will be beneficial for all players. Motion put forward to make a policy change to lower UAA weight to 15% and scored scrimmages to 85%. Motion seconded and carried.

Will also look to use old jerseys or pinnies vs the helmet stickers during evaluations as the stickers were difficult for evaluators.

Division coordinators to play more of a role during evaluations this year.

- v. RISE update Will adopt a U12A team along with U14A and U16A. Looking to potentially add U19A or U16B in order to evenly swap registrations. Will lose many U19 players to Strathmore if a RISE team is not formed for that age level.
- vi. Jersey update

  - 2. Order of new jerseys? Do we want to order new jerseys with more teams moving to RISE? With rebranding half the association, we should finish the remainder of the association. Will get the actual cost to vote on at the June board meeting.
