Please review the following before completing the Eligibility for Raffle Licence (Total Ticket Value \$20,000 and Less Only) application form. This form is used to determine a group's eligibility with the Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis Commission (AGLC) as a charitable or religious entity eligible to conduct a raffle event. This is not an application for a raffle licence.

- The Eligibility Unit will process the completed application within 3 5 business days. Processing will take longer if the form is incomplete or there is not enough information provided.
- The applicant group is not required to be incorporated, but must be a non-profit and have an elected executive.
- For minor sports groups, the number of voting members (18 yrs. and over) is the total number of parents of the youth participants.
- Complete both the Eligibility for Raffle Licence and the Internet Account Request forms and submit them together to our office. Contact information is on the top of both forms.
- If the group's eligibility is approved, the approval with the assigned AGLC ID# will be forwarded to the group via email providing information on how to get your licence.
- In order to obtain a raffle licence(s), there are two options:
 - By using the group's Internet Account a licence could be obtained on-line at no charge through AGLC website. If you submitted the Internet Account Request form you will receive an email providing instruction on activating the account and setting up a password; or
 - The group could go to their local Registry Office, provide their AGLC ID# and upon paying the applicable service fee, may obtain a raffle licence.
- Any questions regarding your raffle event can be directed to Raffle Licensing at 780-447-8600 or toll free at 1-800-272-8876 during regular business hours.
- Any changes or amendments to the licence must be submitted to AGLC and be approved prior to any changes being implemented.
- When the event is complete, or the last draw listed on the licence is finished, the licence is expired. Should you wish to hold another raffle event, please obtain a new raffle licence at the Registry Office or obtain on-line.
- There is no need to resubmit an eligibility application to AGLC as long as the group has not ceased gaming activities for more than a two (2) year period. **Exception**: Minor sports teams are required to reapply each season
- Ensure you review Raffle Terms and Conditions to understand the financial reporting obligations. Raffle Terms and Conditions are available at aglc.ca.
