




2018/2019 vs. 2019/2020







### **Executive Positions**

### Vice President (2 year term):

- Shall attend all Board of Director (BOD) meetings
- Shall perform duties of the President in their absence or at their request and shall have all rights and powers of the President when acting as so.
- When acting as President, shall not have the right to vote except in the case of a tie.
- Shall assist the President in performing his/hers duties and may hold the position of Chairperson of any Ad hoc- or Standing Committee.
- In the absence of the President shall co-sign cheques by the Treasurer.
- Shall perform other duties as assigned.

### Treasurer (2 year term):

- Shall attend all BOD meetings
- Shall pay all accounts by cheque, signed by self and one of either the President or Vice-President
- Shall collect and receive annual dues or assessments levied by the IRA and shall be responsible for the deposit of the same in whatever bank the Executive may order. He/she shall properly account for all funds of the IRA and keep such books as may be directed. He/she shall present a full detailed account of receipts and disbursements to the Executive whenever requested and shall prepare, or have prepared for submission to the AGM a statement of the financial position of the IRA.
- Shall arrange for the audit of the books on an annual basis, noting June 30 as year end.
