

# KRA EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

## Emergency Personnel

A certified trainer will be present during all official practices, games, tournaments or KRA on-ice events.

## Emergency Communication

Direct line to 911 is located in the score-keepers box in all KRA utilized ice facilities.

## Emergency Equipment

There are AED's located in multiple areas of each facility. Each trainer carries a first aid kit within their trainer's bag.

## Roles of First Responders

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill
2. Call EMS
  - a. Name, location and telephone number of caller
  - b. Nature of emergency
  - c. Number of casualties
  - d. Condition of casualties
  - e. First aid treatments being given
  - f. Specific directions as needed to locate emergency scene
  - g. Other information as requested by dispatcher
3. Emergency equipment retrieval
4. Direction of EMS to scene
  - a. Designate individuals to wait at main entrances to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene
5. Scene Control: limit scene to first aid responders and move bystanders away from area
