



1. Coaches may discipline players who do not attend practices and games, especially when the player has not given prior notice or provided a reasonable excuse, or when players fail to make an effort, refuse to follow instructions, or do not conduct themselves according to the principles of fair play.
2. All players are to be treated equally. Discipline may include, but not be limited to, having a player sit out or dismissing a player from a game or practice. In extreme circumstances, the coach may request the dismissal of a player via the Coaching Director to the Board of Directors for their approval.
3. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated on or off the ice by players, coaches or parents/spectators. NWRA reserves the right to impose suspensions over and above those that may be issued by either the WRL or RM.
