

OGHA POLICIES & PROCEDURES

GOALTENDER RETENTION REBATE

The OGHA recognizes the importance of developing and retaining players as goaltenders in the Association.

ELIGIBILITY

1. House League / Local League players who are designated as the goalie of the team and does not play another position during the season.
2. House League / Local League players who are designated as the regular goalie and play 70% of the team's total games.
3. House League / Local League players who share the goaltending duties with one other player on an every other game basis where the each plays out when not playing as a goaltender. The full rebate will be divided in half with each player receiving a 50% rebate.
4. Players who are signed and rostered as a goaltender. These players only play as a goaltender.
5. Registration with the OGHA in the following season and commitment as a goaltender for that season.

ALL rebates will be paid as a refund upon that player's registration the following season. The only exception is a player who is aging out of the Midget division. These players will receive a refund based on the above criteria.

A full rebate shall be \$200

A half rebate shall be \$100
