Sun Parlour Female Hockey Association Code of Conduct – SPFHA Membership

If any parent/guardian interferes in any manner with an official or player of the Association or with the playing of a game, the child of that parent/guardian may be suspended for a minimum of one (1) game and the matter referred to the Board for further action. Parents/guardians are expected to familiarize themselves with the Association's rules of conduct for players and parents and to abide by those rules.

This Code of Conduct identifies the standard of behaviour, which is expected of all SPFHA members and participants, which for the purpose of this policy shall include all players, parents/guardians, coaches, officials, volunteers, Directors, officers, committee members, convenors, team managers, trainers and administrators involved in SPFHA activities and events.

- 1. SPFHA is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants of the Association shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner consistent with the values of the SPFHA, which include fairness, integrity and mutual respect.
- 2. During the course of all SPFHA activities and events, members shall avoid behaviour, which brings the Association or the sport of hockey into disrepute, including and not limited to use of alcohol, use of non-medical drugs and the use of alcohol by minors.
- 3. The SPFHA members and participants shall at all times adhere to the SPFHA operational policies and procedures, to rules and regulations governing SPFHA events and activities and to the rules and regulations governing any competitions in which the member participates on behalf of the Association.
- 4. Members and participants of the SPFHA shall not engage in any activity or behaviour, which interferes with a competition or with any player or team's preparation for a competition or which endangers the safety of others.
- 5. Members of the Association shall refrain from the comments or behaviours, which are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. In particular, behaviour, which constitutes harassment or abuse, will not be tolerated. This includes any abuse or harassment that is conveyed electronically and includes all social networks.
- 6. At least one adult family member of a player rostered in the SPFHA must take the on-line OWHA Respect in Sport (Parent Program) and provide proof of same to the Association.
- 7. Anonymous correspondence, electronic or otherwise is not to be sent to any Member of the Association. The SPFHA Board will not be responded to or act upon any such correspondence except at the discretion of the President. Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary actions in accordance with the SPFHA Discipline Policy and the OWHA discipline policy.
