



TRA VOLUNTEER POLICY

- Transcona Ringette Association is a not-for-profit organization staffed entirely by volunteers. To offer our program, we require parent volunteers to take on various roles: Board of Directors, Team Staff, Tournament volunteers, other special events, etc.
- 2. Included in registration fees is a refundable volunteer deposit in an amount determined by the TRA board.
- 3. Each parent and/or player are required to provide a minimum of 6 hours of volunteer time during the season.
- 4. Duties that count towards each player's volunteer requirement include the following:
 - a. Taking a position on the TRA Board;
 - b. Assisting with a promotional event, such as Come Try Ringette;
 - c. Volunteering for the annual Transcona Ringette Tournament;
 - d. Volunteering for WRL All Star Game;
 - e. Volunteering for WRL Playoff Weekend; and
 - f. Other events and opportunities that may arise.
- 5. Players must be 16 years or older in order to help with events without parental support and to qualify for their association volunteer requirement.
- 6. Once the minimum 6 hours have been achieved, the deposit will be refunded.
