

Westlock Lacrosse Association Registration Policy

For Novice, Peewee, Bantam and Midget teams:

Team Size: maximum 18 runners plus 2 goalies, per GELC rules; all teams require a minimum of 12 registered players

For Tyke and Mini-Tyke teams:

Team Size: will be set by the WLA Executive each year, based upon the "LTAD" Guidelines adopted by the GELC for the current season.

Registrations will be accepted in the following order:

- 1) Priority given to players registered in the previous season, who register for the current season within 4 days after the Westlock Lacrosse Association's annual Registration Night. Registration forms must be accompanied by payment, and they will be recorded in the order received by the WLA Registrar.
- 2) New players who register on Registration Night will be accepted on a first-come basis (in the order the receipts are written).
- 3) Other players who apply after registration night will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis when payment and registration form is received by the WLA Registrar.
- 4) If there are more than the maximum number of players registered for a team, the extra players will be placed onto a waiting list in the order registrations have been received.

The Westlock Lacrosse Association's philosophy is to offer lacrosse to all interested players, and every effort will be made to accommodate everyone who is interested in joining.

If there are sufficient registrations to form more than one team at any level, the Executive will consider all circumstances and determine how the players will be placed onto teams, per the WLA Evaluation Process Policy. Only as a last resort will we turn away players.

(Please note that this Policy does not cover the Junior team; a separate policy has been developed for that team.)

This Registration Policy was approved at the 2008 AGM, and revised to include Tyke and Mini-Tyke teams at the January 16, 2013 Executive Meeting.
