ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

The Prairie Cup tournament is a development program. We work to develop all aspects of our athletes including their conduct in and outside of the game. To support this goal, Alberta Lacrosse expects players, coaches, managers, and parents participating in our program to demonstrate respect for others and the rules of the game; inclusiveness; fair play; and ethical conduct always in keeping with the Mission, Vision, and Values of the Alberta Lacrosse Association and the principles of True Sport Canada.

It is a privilege to play in the Prairie Cup. With privilege comes responsibilities. To participate in the Prairie Cup Tournament, Athletes must agree to uphold the Alberta Lacrosse Code of Conduct.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Respect others:

- I will treat opponents, coaches, managers, officials, Prairie Cup staff, game volunteers, and spectators with respect, both in victory and defeat.
- I will refrain from criticizing other athletes, coaches, and officials.
- I will not make comments or behave in ways that are abusive, offensive, racist, sexist, or otherwise belittling or demeaning to others.
- I will not use profane, insulting, harassing, or otherwise offensive language.
- I will accept the decisions of coaches and officials and show them respect.
- I will uphold the Alberta Lacrosse Association's Social Media policy which is designed to support respect in sport.

Respect for sport:

- I will strive for personal achievement and excellence through a full and honest effort.
- I will honor and respect the spirit and traditions of lacrosse.
- I will play aggressively but without hostility, and behave graciously in triumph or defeat.

Play fair:

- I will play honestly and cleanly. I will not endanger the safety of others through my actions.
- I will know and obey the rules of the game in both letter and spirit.
- I will not use recreational drugs, tobacco, alcohol, or vape products.
- I will comply with the requirements of the Canadian Center for Ethics in Sport (CCES) and abstain from the use of performance-enhancing and/or prohibited substances and/or strategies.

Include everyone:

- I will help to create an environment where everyone feels welcome, respected, and valued,
- I will include everyone, regardless of creed, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation or ability.
- I will conduct myself in ways that allow others to feel safe, comfortable and engaged in our sport.
