

AMBA Mini House Game Rules

- 1. Games will be played with a four (4) vs. four (4) format
- 2. Ball size: 5
- 3. Hoop height: 8 feet 6 inches
- 4. Foul line: 15 feet from base line or 3 feet closer than marked foul line
- 5. Each team will have a minimum of four (4) players and a maximum of ten (10)
- 6. Games shall consist of two (2) halves of twenty-three (23) minutes
 - a. Running time and one (1) minute stop time at end of each half
 - b. There shall be a two (2) minute half time break
 - c. The clock shall be stopped for time outs and injuries
- 7. Each team shall have two (2) time outs in first half and two (2) time outs in second half
- 8. Substitutions should be made every three (3) minutes (or first stoppage of play nearest to that time). There should be no double shifts if you have a team of 8 or more
- 9. All teams must employ a man-to-man defense
- 10. No intentional double teaming of the ball carrier is allowed
- 11. There is no screening on or off the ball
- 12. Bonus foul shots occurs on the 8th team foul in each playing half
- 13. There will be no overtime in regular season games, and a game will end in a tie
- 14. The season final championship tournament can go into overtime, a winner must be determined
 - a. The game will start with a position at half court and each team will shot at same basket from the second half of regulation play
 - b. The first team to score four (4) points or the team leading at the end of three (3) minutes run time period is the victor, whichever comes first.
 - c. The clock will only be stop-time in the last 30 seconds of the three (3) minute overtime period
 - d. Each team will be allowed one-minute timeout for the entire overtime period. No time outs will be carried over from the second half of regulation
 - e. If the game remains tied at the end of 3 minute period, the second overtime will begin with possession at the half and winner will be determined by the first team to score a point. This includes any type of point scored including a foul shot.
