1.0 OVERVIEW

All players must be registered with AMHA before participating in any on-ice activity. They must reside in the AMHA boundary unless exceptional circumstances, see below in 2.0 of this policy.

All new to AMHA registered players must show proof of residency by way of a city utility bill, driver's license and/or lease/purchase agreement and a birth certificate.

2.0 EXCEPTIONS TO BOUNDARY

All players must reside in the AMHA boundary, no players from outside the boundary will be allowed to play in AMHA except for the following:

- 2.1 Players whose local MHA does not have a division for them to play and thereby required by Hockey Alberta guidelines to register with AMHA.
- 2.2 Female players where their Home Association does not have a female team or division for them to play in.
- 2.3 If AMHA is requested by another MHA to include players in our system. This will only be allowed where all Hockey Alberta qualifications are met and agreed to by the Executive. This will only apply for the season the request is made.
- 2.4 Players that are wanting to try out for one of our high-performance teams (AAA or AA) that fall within the draw zone set out by Hockey Alberta.
- 2.5 Annually the Executive Committee will decide if we are allowing imports or players who fall outside of our draw zone to try out for our U13 AA, U15 AA, U15 AAA, U16 AAA, U16 AAA, U18 AA and U18 AAA as a second tryout.
