## Safety/Charge Person name & cell # \_\_\_\_\_

Safety Person takes control of any emergency situation, assesses injury and decides if an ambulance/medical care is required. If situation is serious, Safety Person indicates need for Call Person, Control Person and medical person (if available) to activate.

## Call Person name & cell # \_\_\_\_\_

Call Person makes the connection to 911, requesting medical assistance and remains in communication with the emergency department. Call Person must have facility information included on this page and provide instructions as required to EMS

## Control Person name & cell # \_\_\_\_\_

Control Person has knowledge of and access to emergency equipment of the facility (AED, first aid kit, fire extinguisher, etc). The Control Person interacts with facility personnel, spectators, parents, referees, and players, as required to facilitate proper medical access. The Control Person meets EMS and provides direction to injured player.

### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

The game official continues to be in charge of the overall environment.  
Officials should be aware that if the safety person requests assistance, there may be a number of pre-determined people who will respond and will require access to the ice  
If an ambulance is called, officials should send both teams to their dressing rooms



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
