Athlete Development ARA to provide to a maximum of seventy-two (72) hours of athlete development ice – roughly three (3) a week X twenty-four (24) weeks. This has traditionally been what ARA has provided for power skating in the past. Teams would get roughly eight (8) of these ice times over the season (not necessarily exactly every 3 weeks). Cost is ~\$15,000. Teams would be on their own to hire various applicable instructors for this extra team ice. Total cost would be ~\$18,700.
