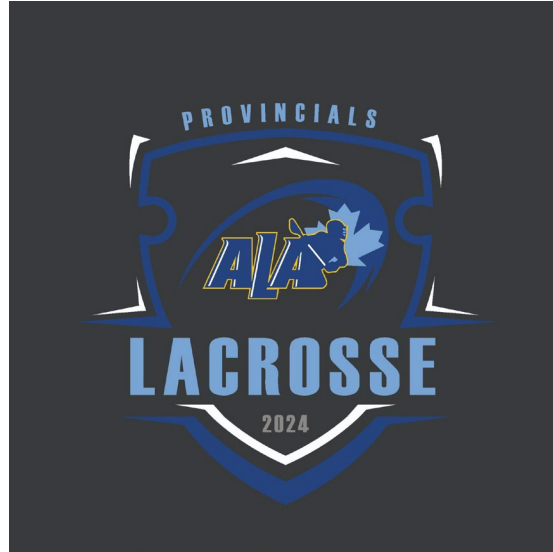

Each floor surface will have an OIC/Supervisor

Home teams are responsible for their fans, any and all fans that are unruly will be asked to leave, officials on floor or tournament volunteers may give one warning or may immediately ask offending party to leave, they will be given 1 minute to exit (two shot clocks), failure to leave in a timely manner WILL result in forfeit of the game being played.

All referee decisions on floor are FINAL, there will be no video review for on floor decisions

To place an appeal with the Provincials Committee, the appealing team must put a \$300 non-refundable fee forward. The appeal must be made in writing and must be received no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the game. If game conclusion time is missing from the game sheet the scheduled game time conclusion shall be used. If any game or portion thereof is to be replayed, the refund will be given after that conclusion. The decision of the Provincials Committee is final unless the sanction carries beyond the tournament.

Game score and updated standings will be posted on the ALA Provincial Website as well as at the Tournament Host tables at each location.

Dressing Room Keys and Assignments:

Dressing Room Assignments will be posted in each facility by the facility staff. Teams are permitted in dressing rooms 30 minutes prior to game time.

Game Sheets:

All game sheets are provided by the ALA and can be picked up at the host table by the home team.

Teams are responsible to fill out their team information on each game sheet prior to the game start, or verify the information is correct.

After each game please bring the game sheet back to the tournament host table.

Game Format

All Medals games are posted in schedule on webpage

A Provincials - best of three

B Provincials - Pool Play

6 teams in each division (including host team) 3 teams in each pool
Semi finals played Sunday Morning
Medal games played Sunday afternoon

GAME TIMES: As per ALA Regulation 9.02

Please also note ALA regulation 9.04 below

9.04 In U11, U13, U15, and U17 lacrosse, if five (5) minutes before the scheduled end time of the game time slot for league games, there is more than five (5) minutes left on the clock, the clock shall be reset to two (2) minutes and play shall continue in stop time to the end of the game, for each of U11, U13, U15, and U17 box lacrosse . As required, a game may be called at this time if an injury is present and cannot be taken care of in a timely fashion.

HOME teams must be prepared to change their jersey if asked to do so by the Referee.

SHOT CLOCK: will be operated by an ALRA official; **TIME KEEPER** will be provided by the HOME team; the **SCOREKEEPER** will be provided by the **VISITOR**; and both will provide penalty box personnel.

OVERTIME: For Semi Final games and Medal games

Goalies will NOT switch ends, there will be a five (5) minute rest period followed by a fifteen (15) minute sudden victory period. If no goal is scored the goalies will switch ends and continue with five (5) minute rest periods between each fifteen (15) minute sudden victory period.

Points for pool play are as follows: TWO points for a win, ONE point for tie and ZERO points for a loss are awarded.

In the event of a tie in point standings in a competition, final standings shall be determined as follows:

- If two teams are tied, the winner of the game or games between the two teams advances. If a tie still exists, the goal average formula listed below will be used.
- If three or more teams are tied, and if one team has defeated the other teams with which it is tied after round robin play, the team shall advance.
- Otherwise, GOAL AVERAGE FORMULA: Only the goals scored in games between the tied teams are used in the goal average formula for tie breaking. The team with the highest ratio advances.
- Otherwise, GOALS AVERAGE FORMULA: Only the goals scored in games between each other plus common opponents are used in the goal average formula for tie breaking. The team with the highest ratio advances.
- Otherwise, GOALS AGAINST FORMULA: Using goals for and against in all games played by the tied teams. $GOALS\ FOR / (GOALS\ FOR + GOALS\ AGAINST)$
 - The formula is applied once to rank all tied teams.
