CRESTING POLICY & WAIVER

This policy applies to all Curling Alberta Provincial Championship events, with the exception of the Travelers and Wheelchair categories.

The following items apply to both the outer and under garments. See diagram as reference.



EXCLUSIVITY AREA – TOP 40% OF GARMENT FRONT PLUS SHOULDERS, COLLAR and NAPE OF NECK

If any logos or crests cannot be removed prior to competition and therefore need to be temporarily covered to be compliant with this policy, a professional-looking application of a patch/covering of a similar colour of the garment is acceptable. Sponsor cresting is not permissible on pants or skirts.

Curling Alberta reserves the right to require additional crests in any location at its sole discretion.

NEW: Manufacturer logos are not permitted on the chest area; the only acceptable areas for manufacturer logos within the exclusivity zone are on the nape of the neck, collar, or shoulder.

The following 3 sentences were removed as of Dec. 16, 2018 for the 2018-19 season only (note these policies will be in effect for the 2019-20 season): Manufacturer labels shall not be marked conspicuously, nor shall they appear more than twice per item of clothing. Identification on clothing, hats, and gloves is deemed marked conspicuously if the label is greater than 12 cm² (4.7 in²). Equipment identification that is greater than 10% of the surface area is deemed marked conspicuously.

OUTER GARMENTS (JACKETS)

All Events (televised & non-televised):

Below are the cresting requirements for Provincial Championship team apparel for outer garments (jackets). See diagram for further details. One crest per player and coach will be supplied by Curling Alberta.

The Curling Alberta crest must be worn on right chest.

Women's Provincial Championship- Scotties crest.

Men's Provincial Championship – Boston Pizza Roundel crest

Women's Provincial Championship- Jiffy Lube crest.

All other events- title sponsor crest. If there is no title sponsor for the event the area must be blank.

Men's Provincial Championship – Blank

A

Team sponsor crests – unlimited team sponsor logos per sleeve, up to the shoulder. The back of the jacket and the bottom 60% of the front of the jacket can have team sponsor cresting as per the attached diagram (player's names and numbers are also allowed). Team sponsor cresting cannot conflict with the event's title or presenting sponsor. Cresting from other events and/or years may also be placed in these areas.

UNDERGARMENTS (SHIRTS)

Non-Televised Events: Undergarments may be void of all cresting. If a team chooses to add team sponsor cresting to its undergarments, the following expectations apply.

- 1** Blank
- 2** Blank
- 3** Title sponsor crest; two crests per player will be provided. If there is no title sponsor for the event and a crest is not provided by Curling Alberta, the area must be blank.

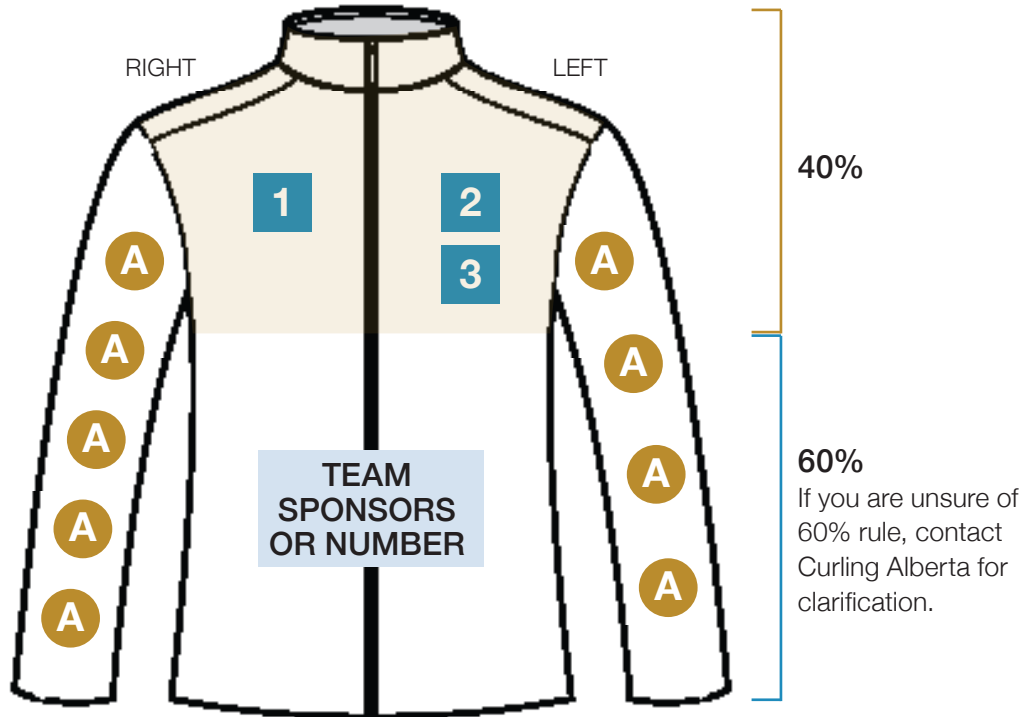
Televised Events: Women's (Jiffy Lube Alberta Scotties Tournament of Hearts), Men's (Alberta Boston Pizza Cup, presented by Best Western)

Below are the cresting requirements for Provincial Championship team apparel for all undergarments (shirts) during televised events, regardless of whether the team adds team sponsor cresting. See diagram for further details. Two crests per player will be supplied by Curling Alberta.

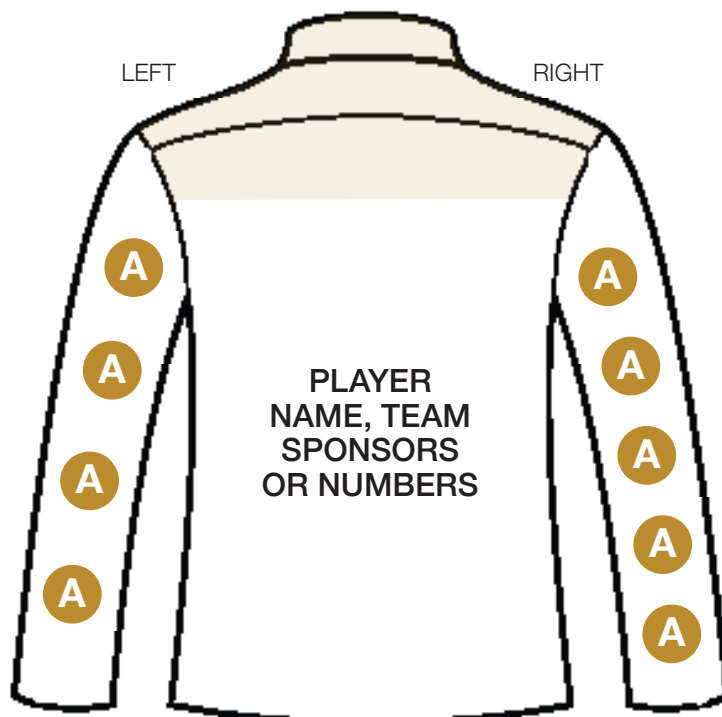
- 1** Curling Alberta crest

CRESTING POLICY & WAIVER

Teams will not be allowed to compete at Provincial Championships unless the entire team (including coaches) complies with the Cresting Policy outlined in the CURLING ALBERTA Competitor's Guide.

- I. All clothing and equipment must be cleared with the Head Official at the pre-competition practice.
- II. Any violation of this policy will result in the immediate forfeit of the game being played.

Curling Alberta and the Head Official of a Provincial Championship have the right to disqualify teams who do not conform to the Cresting Policy.
