



Player Card Policy

Relevant Operating Rules:

Teams 10. *Each team official (including female attendants) on the bench must have an ASA approved photo identification card, issued by the player's team official's local District or league office, at each game or they will be considered an illegal participant in the game. F35*

4.2 *Each player including reserve team and youth players must have an ASA approved photo identification card, issued by the player's local District or league office at each game or they will be considered an illegal participant in the game.*

5.4 *All occupants of the technical area must be eligible to participate in the game, present their approved ID card to the game official, and be recorded on the game sheet.*

- 1) Each individual player will present their district issued player card to the match officials prior to participation in the match
 - a) Player cards presented in binders or other holders will not be accepted.
 - b) Photos, photocopies or electronic versions of player cards will not be accepted.
- 2) Match officials will notify the head coach of each team if their game sheet includes players who have not presented a valid player card. Teams then have the option to:
 - a) Produce the missing player card(s)
 - b) Inform the match officials that the missing card(s) is(are) on the way
 - i) Remove the player(s) from the game sheet. Players not on the game sheet cannot:
 - (1) participate in the match
 - (2) occupy the technical area
- 3) any player(s) who have participated in the match without having presented valid identification will be clearly noted on the game sheet and considered an ineligible participant in the game.
