



Pre-Game League Trophy Presentation Procedure

11.1 *Teams will be listed based on the number of points obtained in AMSL games with first place and the AMSL trophy going to the team with the highest total points.*

- 1) At least 48 hours in advance of the presentation, Alberta Soccer will notify both teams that the league trophy will be presented before their match.
- 2) Game sheet and player card review, and player line-up and kit inspection will take place prior to the walk-out.
- 3) 20 minutes prior to kick off, match officials will be completing pre-game inspections and Alberta Soccer representatives will prepare the trophy at midfield.
- 4) 15 minutes prior to kick off, match officials will do traditional walk out with both teams (all players) and meet Alberta Soccer representatives at midfield.
- 5) Alberta Soccer Representatives will present the League trophy to the Championship team.
- 6) Once the presentation has concluded, the non-Championship team will have additional time to warm up.
- 7) During this time, the Championship team will have three pictures taken by an Alberta Soccer Representative as follows and have any remaining time to use for warm up:



- a) Captain, Coach and AMSL Commissioner (or Alberta Soccer representative).
 - b) Full team
 - c) Full team with AMSL Commissioner (or Alberta Soccer Representative)
- 8) Once completed, match officials will call captains for handshake and coin toss
- 9) Game will commence
