SENIOR ALL-STAR GAME INFORMATION PACKAGE

March 27-28, 2026

1. AFFILIATION

The SHOOTING STARS is an independent organization dedicated to showcasing, promoting and developing girls' basketball in Alberta. We are members of AYBC and Basketball Alberta.

2. CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

To confirm your participation in the SENIOR ALL-STAR GAME, you must complete the registration process and pay the participation fee online. If there are any issues with the on-line registration let us know.

3. FORMAT

We will divide players into equal teams. We do our best to place players into even teams to try and make for competitive games.

4. ATHLETES COMMITMENT

All athletes accepting the invitation to participate in the SHOWCASE are expected to commit to all events:

a) Friday AWARDS GALA	b) 3 on 3 Tournament
c) Team Photo session	d) Saturday Practice
5) Saturday game	

If there is a special problem or conflict please let me know as soon as possible and we will work something out.

5. PARTICIPATION FEE

All participants in the Senior SHOWCASE will be charged a \$150 fee to cover some of the the cost of staging this event. We have little sponsorship money available to support this event so must charge a participation fee.

A letter is provided that you may use to request your school, local business or an individual to sponsor you. If you cannot get a sponsor then you must pay the fee.

For the \$150 fee the athlete will receive the following:

- a) Participation in game.
- b) Game jersey with crest, number and players name.
- c) 3 on 3 Tournament
- d) Athletic bag with gift items
- e) Team photo.
- f) A souvenir all-star medallion
- g) Awards Gala Ticket

6. GAME UNIFORM

On the registration form please indicate your preferred uniform number. If more than one person requests the same number, one player will be given an alternative number. For sizing they will be girls' sizes.

7. GAME SHORTS

Please wear black shorts during the game. Shooting Stars shorts are available for purchase or supply your own black shorts.

8. CHECK IN

Please check in at FOOTHILLS ALLIANCE CHURCH, prior to the Awards Gala on Friday. Check in for Seniors is from 5:45-6:15. Please make sure you are on time for the check in. You will receive your package at that time.

9. ITINERARY

Make sure that you check your itinerary for all events and starting times. It is essential that you are on time for all events. The itinerary is subject to change, based on our final numbers. Changes will be posted on the website and communicated to you as they arise.

10. EVENTS LOCATION

For those not familiar with Calgary, BEARSPAW CHRISTIAN SCHOOL is located at 15001 69th St. NW, Calgary. FOOTHILLS ALLIANCE CHURCH is located at 333 Edgepark Blvd. NW, Calgary

11. AWARDS GALA

The SHOOTING STARS GALA will start at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, March 27, in the banquet hall at FOOTHILLS ALLIANCE CHURCH. Each athlete will receive one ticket to the GALA as part of their participation fee.

We are doing a catered buffet . again, this year for the Awards Gala.

The menu for the meal will be announced shortly.

If you have one of the following dietary restrictions let us know please:
a) dairy b) gluten c) vegetarian d) vegan. You can indicate this on your online registration.

You will sit with your team at the Awards GALA.

Parents are welcome to attend the Awards GALA but must pay for their ticket. Tickets are \$40 each and may be ordered and paid for online. Deadline for ordering GALA is Monday, March 23rd.

12. GAME AWARDS

A three-point contest will be held. Details will be shared shortly. The winner will be presented with a trophy and a gift card. Immediately following each game, an MVP award will be presented to a player from each team.

13. GAME VIDEO

We will be professionally filming all games. We will have games posted on line. More details on this TBA. We plan on live streaming games again this year and will provide links before the event.

14. TEAM PHOTOS

Team pictures will be taken prior to your game. Each player will receive a team picture by e-mail. This will be sent the week after the event.

15. SKILLS/ CONDITIONING

It is extremely important for you to be working on your skills and conditioning. We want to showcase your skills and see you play at your best. There will be a number of college and university coaches in attendance, so it is important that players are in their best condition. It is in your best interest to be in the best shape possible.

16. PRACTICE

Please make sure that you have proper practice gear for your practice. Please be on time for your practice as practice time is limited this year.

18. 3 on 3 TOURNAMENT

All participants will be placed on a 3 on 3 team and compete for their division championship. Awards will be presented to the division champions. Please bring a reversible jersey or a light and dark t-shirt for the tournament.

19. JERSEYS TUCKED IN!!

During the game, all players are asked to keep their jerseys tucked in. We want this to be a first-class event and do not want you to look sloppy. We ask for your co-operation with this.

20. ATHLETIC TRAINER

An athletic trainer will be available at practices and the game. The trainer will be available prior to the game and practices as well as the 3 on 3 tournament. Please be early if you need to be taped. Ice will be available at the game and practice sites.

21. BEARSPAW CHRISTIAN FACILITY

Thanks to BEARSPAW CHRISTIAN SCHOOL. We appreciate the use of their excellent facility.

22. SOUVENIR CLOTHING

A number of souvenir items will be on sale Saturday throughout the day. We will have black shorts, hoodies and half-zip tops available, as well as some sale items.

23. INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

In case of inclement weather, we are not able to give refunds. If a player is unable to travel to the event we will send her the award and souvenir items. Regardless of weather, our event will not be cancelled.

24. REFUND POLICY

Our refund policy is that we will give refunds up until two weeks prior to the event if we can replace the player. Refunds will not be given if a player pulls out in the two weeks leading up to the event. In case of a late sickness or injury the player may still participate in the event or we will send them their awards and souvenir items, but not a refund.

25. COLLEGE EXPOSURE

One of the benefits of playing in the game is the exposure from Alberta college/ university coaches. In the past, many of the Alberta University head coaches have coached in the senior game as well as college coaches.

26. PLAYING TIME

All participants will receive equal playing time.

27. BASKETBALL ALBERTA MEMBERSHIP

All participants must have a current Basketball Alberta Membership. If you currently don't have one you may purchase one on the Basketball Alberta web-site. This ensures that we are properly sanctioned and that all participants are properly insured.
