Appendix 6: League Communication Protocol

Coaches, Managers: If you have questions or concerns; (please follow below)

- 1. First call your Local Minor Hockey Association President and/or All Peace APHL Representative.**
- 2. Your local rep will solve your problem or answer your question. If they cannot, then they will contact the APHL Divisional Commissioner for advice.**
- 3. If the APHL Commissioner is unable to help, they will call the APHL Division Vice President or President.**
- 4. All contact with the APHL Commissioners and APHL Vice Presidents will be done ONLY via the APHL Representative or the Local Minor Hockey Association President. (NO COACHES, MANAGERS OR PARENTS)**
- 5. This protocol is in place to ensure that the Local Minor Hockey Association is aware at all times of what concerns or problems their teams are experiencing with the APHL and to minimize the number of calls the APHL Commissioners and APHL Vice Presidents are required to answer.**
- 6. No coaches, No Managers, No Parents are to call the League Executive.(see APHL Appendix 3 APHL Fines)**

- a. *Players who reach Threshold 1 due to the accumulation of penalty minutes by the end of the League Regular Season, will have their penalty minutes carried over into the League Playoffs for continued tracking and accumulation.*
- b. *Players who receive a suspension due to the accumulation of penalty minutes that carries over into the Hockey Alberta Provincial Championships or APHL Year End Divisional Tournaments, will be required to serve the suspension at the start of the event. However, the tracking and accumulation of penalty minutes will not be tracked at the Events.*
- c. *Players who do not reach Threshold 1 by the end of the League Regular Season will not have their penalty minutes carried over into the League Playoffs and tracking and accumulation will be stopped.*
- d. *Leagues shall be responsible for the ongoing monitoring of penalty minute accumulations and will be responsible for warning any teams and players who are approaching or trending towards a given threshold.*

Appendix 5: APHL OVERTIME INFORMATION:

- 1) If the game is tied at the end of regulation time. A 5 minute, 3 on 3, STOP TIME, sudden victory overtime period to immediately follow.
- 2) Goaltenders will change ends.
- 3) Penalties which have not expired at the end of regulation time shall carry over into Overtime. The non-penalized team will put an extra player on the ice for each penalty the offending team has.

Examples:

If Team "A" was shorthanded at the conclusion of regulation time, Team "B" would start the overtime with 4 players and Team "A" with 3 players. If Team "A" was short two players, then Team "B" would start with 5 players and team "A" with 3 players.

If Team "A" had two penalties and Team "B" had one penalty, Team "B" would start the Overtime 4 skaters to 3.

If both teams had the same number of penalized players at the end of regulation time the teams would start the Overtime 3 on 3.

Coincidental Penalties would NOT apply to the above scenarios.

At each stoppage of play, the number of players on the ice is to revert to as close to 3 on 3 as the penalties will allow.

Once ALL penalties have been served, at the next stoppage of play, play will revert to 3 on 3.

- 4) If neither team scores in Overtime the game remains tied and is entered into the standings as such.
- 5) \$250.00 Fine for not playing overtime as per the APHL Overtime Policy. This fine will be levied against the home team. In addition to the fine the visiting team will be awarded 2 points for an overtime win.

Appendix 2: APHL Scheduling Meeting

Purpose: The APHL will hold an annual scheduling meeting approximately one week after the completion of the tiering season. Each team will participate in the meeting to schedule all their APHL games for the current season.

Rules/Guidelines:

- a) The Scheduling order for each scheduling meeting will be as follows and may be adjusted each year by the APHL executive.
 - 1) 9:00am – U18 & Female Division
 - 2) 11:00am – U15 Division
 - 3) 1:00pm – U13 Division
 - 4) 3:00pm – U11 Division
 - Each team must arrive a minimum 30 minutes prior to their scheduled time and be seated in the staging area for a review of the scheduling rules.
- b) Each team will be allowed only one team representative to participate in the scheduling meeting.
- c) A draw will be held for seat placement at the scheduling table. Each team will draw a number. The lowest number will take the first spot at the table and will be the first to schedule two games. The highest number will be the last to schedule two games at the table. After the last person has scheduled their two games the format then reverts to the first person who then schedules their next two games.
- d) Each division will be allowed 1 hour and 30 minutes to schedule games. The APHL President will announce 30-minute, 20-minute and 15-minute warnings. At the 15-minute warning the President or Scheduling Director will have control of the scheduling table and assist in completing the scheduling of games.
- e) It is important that each team representative be respectful during the scheduling of games and allow the team who is currently scheduling to have the voice of the scheduling table. There will be zero tolerance for any side scheduling done during the scheduling meeting. If side scheduling occurs when it is not your turn to schedule games the team(s) in violation will have their next round of scheduling forfeited and will wait for the following round to participate in scheduling of their games. It is important that each team has access to all open dates for available ice at everyone's venue.
