Falher Regional Recreation Complex - Restriction Exemption Program

Following the Public Health announcement on September 15th, 2021, Falher Town Council made the motion at their regular meeting on September 20, 2021 to implement the REP (Restriction Exemption Program) for all attendees, program operators and users of the FRRC (Falher Regional Recreation Complex). The Town of Falher will not operate the REP directly (except during Town of Falher events). All sport program operators and kitchen operators will be required to operate and enforce the program in line with the current provincial recommendations.

To enter spaces participating in the Restrictions Exemption Program, people ages 12 and older must provide:

- · proof of vaccination, or
- proof of a privately-paid negative rapid test result taken within 72 hours of service, or
- documentation of a medical exemption

Anyone eligible to be vaccinated (12yrs and older) must provide proof of vaccination (or equivalent to access the facility, see alberta.ca.

If a youth under 18 is accessing the facility for the sole purpose of taking part in a youth (under 18) sport, fitness, and performance activity, they would NOT need to provide proof of vaccination (or equivalent). However once that specified youth programming is complete, should the youth participant want/require continued access to the facility for all other purposes they must check in and provide proof of vaccination (or equivalent). Valid photo identification that matches the vaccine record (only required for adults 18 and over)

Valid paper or digital vaccine record that shows name, vaccine type and date of administration: From September 20 to October 25: proof of partial vaccination (one dose) is considered acceptable as long as the dose was given more than 2 weeks before the time of service. After October 25: proof of full vaccination (two doses) is required. For detailed information on what will be accepted as proof of vaccination or equivalent can be found on the alberta.ca website. All masking and social distancing requirements remain in effect throughout the facility while operating within the REP.
